## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course examines the history of the relationship of Pakistan and Islam. The primary emphasis is to understand Pakistan's creation and development through analyzing the interplay of colonial legacies, ethnic nationalisms, Islam, and geo-strategic global concerns. This course delves too into the question of how definitions of Pakistan and being a Pakistani have changed over time.

Islam and Pakistan is a lecture-cum discussion class. The course follows a chronological narrative: Pakistan's origins; its history to the creation of Bangladesh in 1971; and its subsequent development.
