JOHN AND SUSAN AUSLEY UNDERGRADUATE HISTORY AWARD (\$1000)

Nominations are welcomed from students, faculty and staff for the John and Susan Ausley Undergraduate History Award. It is based on academic merit.

Prize: The recipient shall receive the award for one year (the total award will be distributed 50/50 during fall [\$500] and spring [\$500] semesters of the next academic year). Up to two awards may be announced for the 2024-25 academic year.

Award Criteria: The award recipient will be selected based on academic merit.

- 1. Recipients must have a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or greater.
- 2. <u>Recipients must be History majors engaged in the Honors Program (completing "Honors in the Major" requirements</u>). NOTE: Any student registering for HiTM before the April 1 deadline for the HiTM Progam starting in summer or in fall *counts as being engaged in HiTM and are eligible for this year's Ausley Award*.

Selection must be made each year by April 1st in order for student to make use of the award during their last year of undergraduate study, which shall begin the following fall semester. Please note the earlier *nomination* deadline.
