

The John and Susan Ausley Undergraduate History Award

Nominations are welcomed from students, faculty, and staff for the John and Susan Ausley Undergraduate History Award. The award is based on academic merit.

Eligibility: Recipients must be History majors engaged in the Honors Program (completing "Honors in the Major" requirements. Recipients must have a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or greater.

Award amount: typically \$1,000. The recipient shall receive the award for one year (the total award will be distributed 50/50 during fall [\$ 5 00] and spring [5 500] semesters of the next academic year).

Procedure:

The award recipient will be selected based on academic merit.

- 1. Recipients must have a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or greater
- 2. Recipients must be History majors engaged in the Honors Program (completing "Honors in the Major" requirements). Note: Any student registering for HiTM before the April 1 deadline for the HiTM Program starting in summer or in fall counts as being engaged in HiTM and are eligible for this year's Ausley Award.
- 3. Nominations (can be self-nominating), should include GPA, a statement (100 to 250 words, 12 pt font, double-spaced) about the student's HiTM project (what will they study and why?), and unofficial transcript.

Selection must be made each year by April 1st for student to make use of the award during their last year of undergraduate study, which shall begin the following fall semester. Please note the earlier *nomination* deadline.
