

The History Department Undergraduate Research Paper Award

Each year, the History Department honors excellence among undergraduate History majors and all undergraduate History majors are strongly encouraged to apply.

The winning essay will go well beyond the expectations of the class for which it was written, and it will show the author's potential for undertaking their own independent historical research, which evidences independent critical engagement with primary and secondary material.

Eligibility: All history undergraduate students who have written a paper during the XXXX calendar year (January 1, XXXX to December 31, XXXX). You must still be enrolled to eligible.

Procedure:

Papers should be approximately 8 to 20 pages, typed, double-spaced, 12pt font, and written for a class taught in the History Department at Florida State during the preceding two semesters: XXXX calendar year. Papers must be original historical research based on primary and secondary sources. (Historiographical essays are ineligible).

When you submit your paper, it <u>should not include</u> the professor's written comments or other information, like a grade.

Along with the paper, please include a title cover sheet indicating your name, title of the paper, and your FSU email address.
